Holiday drive for Open M: Thanks to all who helped with the successful drive to get 200 rolls of paper towels for Christmas baskets.

Mountain of Food Friday Dec. 20: Carpool from church at 7:30 AM. We usually spend about 4 hours helping separate, pack, and load food for the clients. There are enough tasks to handle every physical ability level. Jobs range from extremely light and easy to rather intense lifting. The January date for the event will be Jan. 17.

**Adopt-a-family for Christmas:** Each year we provide Christmas gifts and groceries for needy families affiliated with Mogadore Schools. Once again, we will be making cash donations to the school and the staff will take care of purchase, wrapping, and distribution of gifts. We have assured them that we can provide funding for **at least** 25 gifts for needy students, but we have traditionally provided much more. The typical gift will average about \$25; therefore, we will need about \$600. We need everyone's help in order to reach the goal. Ideally, each person who comes to church could give \$30. Realistically, that isn't possible. Some can only afford a few dollars; others could sponsor 3-6 gifts.

PLEASE prayerfully consider how much you will be able to give, and then donate accordingly. Believe it or not, one donation can change a person's lifelong perspective. If you want to help in this way, you can send a monetary donation to church. Monetary donations should be in addition to your usual pledge and have the memo line specify Adopta-family to ensure its proper distribution.

If you choose this option, you may **send your donations as soon as you are ready.** (The earlier the better so that shoppers have ample opportunity to make selections before stock runs out.) If you have any questions of concerns, feel free to call Russ at (330) 628-1552.

**The Mitten Tree** will be in the church from Dec 1. until Jan 5 to collect hats, gloves, mittens, scarves, and socks for distribution to needy children in the Mogadore schools and through *Ellet Good Neighbors*.
